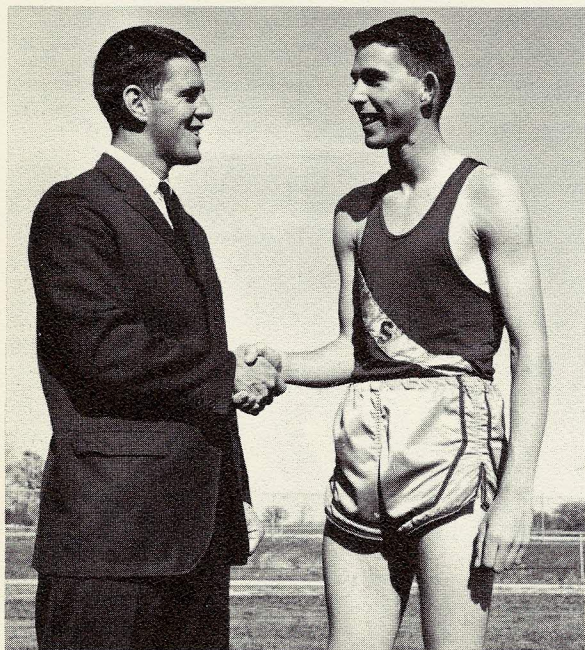


Jay trackmen take third place

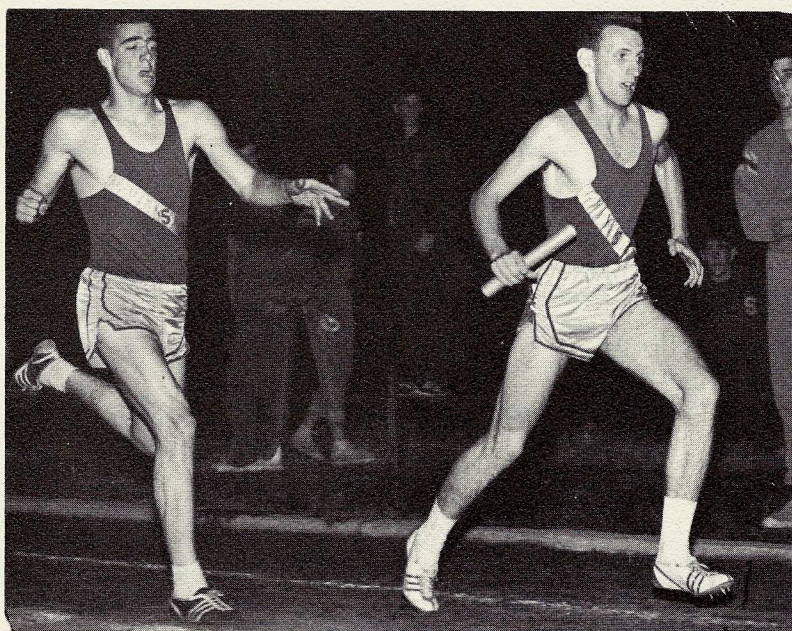
At the state meet at the University of Michigan, Ed Davis broke the school record in the one mile run with a time of 4 minutes, 32.4 seconds. Dennis Lamb won an All-Conference berth as he placed first in the shot put event with a heave of 48 feet, 8 inches. Also a sophomore, Joe Considine set a new team record with a high jump of 5 feet, 9 inches. Nick Larsen, captain of the thinclads, was a leading high jumper.

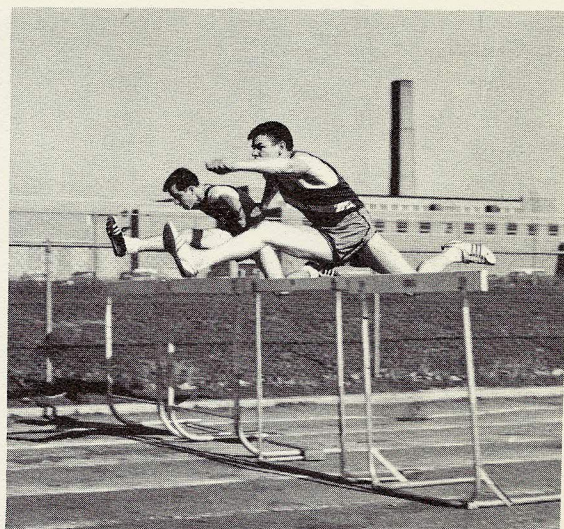


As team members look on, Buzz Jenks hands off the baton to Doug Craig when he starts the last leg of the mile relay.
